8. Will there be a setup fee?

If your artwork is not print-ready, a **setup fee** may apply. This includes resizing, layout adjustments, and preparing the file for accurate cutting or printing. You'll always be notified if a setup fee is required.

9. How long does signage printing take?

Turnaround time is usually **3–5 working days** depending on the type and size of signage. Rush jobs may be possible on request.

10. Do you offer installation services?

Yes, we offer professional installation for vinyl applications and signage in certain areas. Installation fees vary depending on the size, location, and complexity of the job.

11. How should I prepare my surface for vinyl application?

Surfaces must be:

- Clean and dry
- Free from dust, grease, or loose paint
- Smooth (not textured)

For best results, avoid applying to rough, damp, or freshly painted surfaces.

12. Can vinyl graphics be removed?

Yes. Vinyl can be removed without damaging most surfaces. However, depending on the age and exposure of the vinyl, some adhesive residue may remain. We offer removal services if needed.

13. Do I need to pay before printing starts?

Yes. Because each sign or vinyl job is custom-made to your specifications, full payment is required upfront before production begins.

14. Can I reprint a previous sign or graphic?

Yes, we keep your designs on file. Reprints can be ordered easily as long as no changes are needed. If edits are required, a new setup or design fee may apply.
